A letter to all Artists who kindly supported our Pal Art campaign for children with Disabilities in Palestine



2nd September 2021

Dear all

I hope that most of you were aware that we had to postpone the London reception to complete our online auction from October 2020 to October 2021. We had rebooked the Mosaic Rooms in Kensington and all was well until they confirmed that they would have large installations in the main room making a large gathering very impractical. There would be no room to display works of art donated.

We have therefore rather reluctantly agreed to postpone the event and hence the duration of the online auction until April 2022. As our last report confirmed we have been very lucky to have had immensely generous support from Banksy which has really helped us ride out the last 18 months, with flexibility to invest in an adapted minibus for the Nur Shams refugee camp. Now this centre is able to collect children from outside the camp in surrounding communities in area C.

We will continue to sell smaller works of art in the 'buy it now' section and the higher value works there now and in transit will continue to be open for bids over until that reception. It will give us additional time to publicize the auction and collect donated works that are still undelivered.
