

Where is Waleed – competition rules

'Where is Waleed' is promoted by ABCD Bethlehem registered charity (1097623) of Dovecot House Winchester Road Goodworth Clatford Andover Hampshire SP11 7HN

Description: the competition is based on a boy called Waleed travelling a route in Palestine which participants cannot see. They purchase for £5 a grid square (or £20 for 5 squares) in the hope that they will either find Waleed is there (first prize) or on up to 4 grid squares had stayed there (secondary prizes). The competition will run monthly, and participants will be notified by email at the end of each month if they have won a prize.

1. Entry into the competition will constitute acceptance of these terms and conditions.
2. Each participant can buy as many squares as they want.
3. Entry is open to UK residents over 16 years of age.
4. Participants must have supplied an email address and phone number to participate.
5. Prizes will be paid /sent to the winners within 7 days of the end of each monthly competition. Entrants will be notified as to any change in the prize structure via the Website or by contacting participants directly using the contact details provided to us.
6. The promotional material provided forms part of these rules.
7. The top prize will vary month by month and will be advertised on the competition page.
8. Sums raised will be processed as a donation to ABCD Bethlehem (although no Gift Aid will be claimed)
9. Any unclaimed prizes will be re-offered within one month after notification to the participants contact details.
10. ABCD Bethlehem reserves the right to declare the first purchaser of a square subsequently bought by someone else as the winner and in relation to the first prize square the subsequent purchaser's purchase of that square will be converted to a square entitling them to a secondary prize. This may change if technology enables us to blank off purchased squares.
11. ABCD Bethlehem may (without giving any reason or notice at its absolute discretion) modify, terminate, or suspend the Competition in whole or in part. Entrants shall be notified in writing of material changes to these terms before they come into effect.
12. ABCD Bethlehem may amend these terms and conditions at any time. Any significant changes shall be notified via the Website or by contacting participants directly using the contact details provided to us on registration.
13. ABCD Bethlehem's decisions made pursuant to these terms and conditions shall, once made, be final and binding.
14. No liability is accepted for any loss or damage, including the right to receive a prize, suffered by any participant if they have not complied with these participation instructions or for any failure or delay beyond ABCD Bethlehem's reasonable control.
15. All warranties, conditions or guarantees relating to this competition made by or on behalf of ABCD Bethlehem whether express or implied by law are excluded to the maximum extent permitted by law.
16. ABCD Bethlehem's liability to any participant shall be limited to the amount of any prize which have become due to that participant.

ABCD Bethlehem will use participants' information for the purposes of administering the competition to the extent necessary for the competition to be administered and prizes to be delivered to winners and for sending participants information regarding its work and other fundraising opportunities.
